4. Κάνω — To Do / Make

Τι κάνεις; (What are you doing? / How are you?)

5. Μπορώ — Can / Be Able

Μπορώ να πληρώσω; (Can I pay?)

6. Πηγαίνω — Το Go

Πηγαίνω στην Αθήνα. (I am going to Athens.)

7. Καταλαβαίνω — To Understand

Δεν καταλαβαίνω. (I don't understand.)

8. Μιλάω — To Speak

Μιλάτε Αγγλικά; (Do you speak English?)

9. Τρώω — To Eat

Τρώω μουσακά. (I am eating moussaka.)

10. Αγαπάω — **To Love**

Αγαπάω την Ελλάδα! (I love Greece!)
